

Managing cookies in Internet Explorer

Remark

Depending on your browser's version, this procedure may not fully correspond to what you see on your device.

Blocking or allowing cookies

1. Click on **Tools** and then click on **Internet options**.
2. Click on the **Privacy** tab and move the slider adjuster under **Settings** upwards to block all cookies, or downwards to allow all cookies. Then click on **OK**.

As you move the slider adjuster, you will see a description of the types of cookies that are blocked or allowed at that privacy level. That way you can still opt to accept certain types of cookies.

Blocking or allowing cookies at specific websites

1. Click on **Tools** and then click on **Internet options**.
2. Click on the **Privacy** tab and move the slider adjuster to a position between the highest and lowest level, so that not all cookies are allowed or blocked.
3. Click on **Sites**.
4. Enter the address of a website in the **Website address** box and click on **Block** or **Allow**.

As you type, you will see a list of the webpages that you have visited previously. You can click on an address to display in the **Website address** box.

For Belfius websites, you will need to enter "belfius.be" and "belfius.com" like this and then click on **Allow**.

5. Click on **OK**.
6. Move the slider adjuster back to the level you want and click on **OK**.

Deleting cookies

1. Click on **Tools**, select **Security** and then click on **Delete browsing history...**
2. Tick **Cookies** and click on **Delete**.

Managing cookies in Internet Explorer Mobile on Windows Phone

1. In the menu on your device, click on **Applications > Settings**, or open Internet Explorer Mobile and click on the 3 dots below, and open the settings window.
2. To allow or block cookies, tick or untick the box next to **Allow cookies on my phone**.
3. To delete cookies, click on **Delete history**. If you do that, you will not only delete the cookies, but also all of the files stored by your browser, including the history of the pages visited.
4. Close the settings window and Internet Explorer Mobile.
